**MINUTES OF THE MEETING 3/2001**

**13.3.2001**

1. Welcome Remarks by Chairman, Approval of the Agenda, Introduction of Participants  
The Chair of Public Identity Trailblaser, Ms. Ritva Viljanen, welcomed the participants and declared the meeting opened. The participants introduced themselves. The agenda was presented and approved.
2. Feedback of eEurope Smartcards Steering Committee held on 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2001  
Mr. Jan van Arkel gave a presentation of Smartcard Steering Committee meeting, coming events and timetable.  
He introduced also the principal ideas of the Cross Trailblaser pilot. The meeting concluded to participate the cross pilot if it will be commenced.

10. How is it possible to use a public identity in different EU countries in practice. What is required.  
Mr. Simon Corell gave interesting presentation of excisting Swedish smart card system, which is almost alike with the Finnish similar system. He emphasized that present and working solution should be used in future piloting.
11. The criteria of the Pilot project, suggestions and comments /introduction  
Mr. Tapio Aaltonen gave a presentation on piloting. He reminded about the need of close cooperation with TB 2, pointed out the need of minimum dataset. He also emphasized that the Pilot Project services must be attractive to the participants. And furthermore there has to be clear benefit for users and participative companies. We must also recognise the need for a European Directory for CA's that are allowed to issue Public ID certificates

## 12. Co-operation with other TBs

Mr. Andreas Mitrakas (Chairman TB 2) gave a presentation about tasks of TB 2 in order to carryout the cooperation. That is; identify the functional requirements related to each individual Trailblazer; respond to such functional requirements; identify technology requirements for the scope areas of other Trailblazers.

## 13. Funding Issues /introduction

Mr. Gerard Galler presented the requirements of the funding of the pilots and the technical. He gave also short summary of the current status of other TB's proposals. He reminded that TB 1 can't apply for funding, individual organisations must apply and this is not easy - professional help is necessary.

The meeting agreed to continue the work according to the work schedule, first and second Deliverable due on **1. June 2001**. The pilot project has to selected ASAP. The suggestions will be sent to Mr. Voitto Kiviharju by 15. March 2001.
